

# Inkscape Hackfest Proposal

## Introduction

This is a proposal for an Inkscape hackfest to be held in Paris at the end of June. The proposed site of the hackfest is [Carrefour Numérique<sup>2</sup>](#), a fablab/hackerspace located in a large public science museum. The lab uses Inkscape in-house. They host monthly Libre Graphics meetings.

## Site

[Carrefour Numérique<sup>2</sup>](#) is located in the north-east section of Paris and is easy to get to by public transport. A recommended and reasonably priced hotel is nearby. Plenty of high-quality AirBnB rooms are also available in this area.

The space includes five tables equipped with power and wired Internet connections. The space is available to use from Tuesday through Saturday, from Noon to 6:30 PM. (We can have informal pre-lunch meetings in the morning or people can see some of the Paris sites.)

We have been offered three sets of dates: May 29<sup>th</sup> - June 2<sup>nd</sup>, June 20<sup>th</sup> - June 24<sup>th</sup>, or June 27<sup>th</sup> - July 1<sup>st</sup>. For attendance and planning purposes, the last set is preferred. July 1<sup>st</sup> is also when they host monthly Libre Graphics meetings. (We have also been offered space at Mozilla's Paris Office which is more centrally located but more expensive area. Due to their use of Inkscape, meeting at [Carrefour Numérique<sup>2</sup>](#) is preferred.)

Note: CR has offered to coordinate hotel reservations.

# Budget

The actual total cost will depend on the number of attendees and the distance they travel. If we assume 1/4th of attendees will be from the US and 3/4th from Europe, it would be an average travel cost of about \$600. So, very roughly:

- 9 attendees =  $9 \times (\$600 + 6 \times \$45 + 6 \times \$90) = \$12,690$

The meeting place is free and two of the attendees are local.

## Reimbursement Limits

The total reimbursement will be determined similar to how we've done for previous events:

- Up to \$2000 each for Inkscape developers who have contributed for 3+ years and > 200 commits
- Up to \$1500 each for Inkscape developers who have contributed for 2+ years and > 100 commits
- Up to \$1000 each for Inkscape developers who have contributed for 1+ year and > 50 commits
- Up to \$500 each for any Inkscape contributor listed in AUTHORS file with at least 10 commits
